He used the text of Psalm 51:7-12 to outline what we need to do. Our prayer should be that of the psalmist: cleanse me, wash me, create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit. He related it to his experiences on the fire department working with code blues. First, you must pump out the old, stale blood, and let

clean, oxygenated blood flow into the heart. This is reflective of how God creates a clean heart in us. Where our heart is not clean, God cleans us. We need Jesus. God calls us out of the grave to repent and follow Jesus.
